### **Membership Extensions Offered Due to COVID-19**

The International Board of Directors has approved the following policy changes to assist members during the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Extension of the charter renewal from June 30 to July 31.\*
- Extension of chapter verification of audit deadline from July 15 to Sept 15.
- Extension of quartet renewal period by 30 days, from July 31 to August 31.
- Quartet registration fees have been discounted from \$100 USD to \$50 USD from May 1-June 30. On July 1, the renewal will be \$100 USD.
- Extension of the grace period for membership renewals due Jan 31-July 31 from 60 to 150 days. For example, if your membership expired April 30, 2020, you have until Sept. 31, 2020 to renew. Your due date will remain April 30, 2021 when you renew. For member renewals due Aug. 31, you have a 90-day grace period (through November 30), and from Sept. 1 onward, the grace period returns to 60 days.
