Each entry must have the name and contact info listed on the back. The winning entries will be selected by a panel of artists, educators and representatives from the Tippecanoe Latino Festival **based on creativity and incorporating Latino Heritage themes into each drawing or painting.**

Entry must be original and drawn by the child whose name appears on the entry form. Computer generated artwork is NOT acceptable.

Entries will be judged in three age groups. For each age group, prizes will be awarded.

Entries must be submitted from August 26, 2019 to September 7, 2019 by mail or in person, in a sealed envelope, addressed to: LCWE, PO BOX 273, Lafayette, IN, 47902.
