Bass Tournaments

Throughout the summer, the club holds eight bass tournaments at the lake. Anglers must be club members, who meet at the marina between 6:00-6:25AM for registration. Fishing starts at 6:30AM, and weigh in is at the marina at 11:00AM. Each angler can weigh three bass, either largemouth or smallmouth, and the top three weights along with the lunker largemouth and smallmouth bass win cash prizes. An overall tally is also kept to award the top three overall anglers of the entire season. Those awards are presented at the end of the year banquet held at the Lodge. These tournaments provide great competition and fun!

Al Diehl Memorial Children's Tournament

Each summer around July 4th, the club sponsors a children's tournament commemorated to one of our founding members, Al Diehl. Any child 15 years of age and younger can participate and bring their pan fish catch, (no bass) with a 50 fish limit to the marina for counting. The youngsters with the most pan fish in three different age categories win prizes for first, second, and third place and for the longest pan fish.

After the tournament, the club along with the Marina provides a picnic luncheon. The kids have a great time, and the club enjoys hosting the tournament and promoting the great sport of fishing.
