The Shanksville Volunteer Fire Department is counting on your financial support so we can continue to provide fire fighting, emergency medical services, and water rescue for Shanksville Borough, Stonycreek Township, and Indian Lake Borough. In 2017 the department responded to 139 calls in our community.

Though we constantly apply for grants for equipment replacement and hold fundraising events year ‘round your support is **essential** to meet our on-going operating and maintenance expenses for six emergency vehicles and their associated equipment, and the training and outfitting of our firefighters and emergency medical technicians.

Your Fire Department stays involved with the community. Here is a partial calendar of events planned for 2018:

Thanks to frugal use of these funds over many years the Relief Association has been able to purchase, for the first time, a brand new, fully-outfitted Dodge pickup Quick Response vehicle which will go on line later this spring. This is great news because the QRS is dispatched on nearly every call, especially for medical emergencies and accidents, and our current QRS, a refurbished GM Yukon is worn out and no longer economical to keep in service.
