CENSUS 2020 - Information and How to get involved

- It is mandated by Article 1, Section 2 of the Constitution and takes place every 10 years. The next census will take place April 1, 2020. Under the U.S. Constitution, the census is taken every 10 years, with the goal of determining the country's population and where everyone lives.
- Census data helps fund our schools, infrastructure, transportation, health care and more. A complete count means the county receives the funding it deserves.
