COVID Preparedness Plan

The Saint Peter Public Library and Recreation & Leisure Services Department strives to make your experience as safe and fun as possible.

Please read through our preparedness plan below. Keep in mind that procedures may evolve based on current recommendations and guidelines by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

The procedures outlined below cover **outdoor summer programming**.

- Participants will **self-monitor health and well-being** before coming to the library for an event or activity for symptoms outlined above. Temperature needs to be less than 100.4. Do not attend if temperature reads 100.4 or above.
- Participants will **stay home if experiencing symptoms** and quarantine if exposed to a known positive case per MDH. Participants observed with symptoms outlined above will be asked to leave.
- **Masks will be encouraged** outdoors when social distancing is not possible.
- Participants will **avoid congregation in large groups**.
