Dear Sibling in Christ,

We are glad to provide the opportunity for you to use our sanctuaries as a place for private prayer during the Covid-19 pandemic. In order to continue to safely make this space available for yourself and others, you must conform to the following rules.

- Do not enter the church if you are infected, feeling ill, or have been exposed to someone with symptoms of Covid-19.
- Please use the sign-in sheet to provide your name, telephone, and email (for use in contact tracing should another who has entered The Falls Church become ill).
- To enter the sanctuary, you are required to wear a mask. If you did not bring your own, disposable masks are provided.
- Use the provided hand sanitizer.
- Use a provided red Post-it note to mark where in the sanctuary you were seated for cleaning purposes. If you are in the Main Sanctuary, please sit in the easier-to-sanitize pews rather than the fabric covered chairs.
- There is a limit of 10 people in the church at any one time.
- Maintain social distancing of 6 feet minimum.
- Follow posted directions to use separate doors for entry and exit.
- Prayer Books and Hymnals have been removed from the sanctuaries for sanitation reasons, but you are welcome to use the provided prayer resource bulletin. *You may take it with you or recycle it as you leave. Please do not place it for reuse by others.*
- If you fall ill within 14 days after visiting, please let us know immediately by calling 703-241-0003.
- We reserve the right to ask anyone not abiding the above rules to leave church property.
