

The Rev'd Dr Kathy Grieb is the Director of the Center for Anglican Communion Studies and formerly served as the Meade Professor in Biblical Interpretation at the Virginia Theological Seminary. She is also a member of the Anglican Consultative Council currently engaged in organizing the next Lambeth Conference of worldwide Anglican Bishops, scheduled for 2022. In her latest book, *The Story of Romans: A Narrative Defense of God's Righteousness*, Kathy insightfully traces the argument of Paul's letter and shows how it is grounded in the story of God's faithfulness to Israel. Kathy is passionate about "the movement church," the part of the church that is committed to working for peace, civil rights, and economic justice for all. She is an Episcopal priest serving in the Diocese of Washington and has been associated with the Church of St Stephen and the Incarnation for many years.
