

***Sacred Ground* is part of The Episcopal Church's long-term commitment to racial healing, reconciliation, and justice in our personal lives, in our ministries, and our society. This is a 10-part film and readings-based dialogue series on race, grounded in faith. Small groups (meeting about every 2-4 weeks) are invited to walk through chapters of America's history of race and racism, while weaving in threads of family story, economic class, and political and regional identity. Participants are invited to peel away the layers that have contributed to the challenges and divides of the present day – all while grounded in our call to faith, hope and love.**
