

## Replacement of Trunk, Distribution Water Main, and Combined Sewer Rehabilitation at Various Locations

### Norwood and Woodlawn Heights Area

### Project # HED569

The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) continues to manage the capital reconstruction project in the Norwood and Woodlawn Heights Area of Community Boards #5, #7 and #12 in the Bronx, along Bainbridge Avenue from East Gun Hill Road to Jerome Avenue, on Jerome Avenue from Bainbridge Avenue to East 233rd Street, as well as West Burnside Avenue and Phelan Place.

- Continuation of 36" steel trunk water main installation on Jerome Avenue between Bainbridge Avenue and East 213<sup>th</sup>. Street
- Continuation of 36" butterfly valve concrete chamber construction in Phelan Place and West Burnside Avenue intersection
- Installation of cathodic protection wiring and test stations at various locations
- Installation of new traffic signal pole on Jerome Avenue and Shandler Road
- Restoration Roadway pavement in Shandler Road

The Bainbridge Avenue Construction Project includes replacement of water mains and rehabilitation of the combined sewers work. The updated completion date of the project is in the Winter of 2023.

#### Work Performed, 3<sup>rd</sup>. Quarter 2023:

- Completion of the 12" sewer work on East 233<sup>rd</sup>. Street and Jerome Avenue.
- Installation of the new 36" butterfly valve in the West Burnside Avenue and Phelan Place intersection
- Installation of conduit and wiring for the traffic signal at the intersection of Jerome Avenue and Shandler Road
- Roadway pavement restoration performed at the intersection of Jerome Avenue and Shandler Road

#### Anticipated Work, 4<sup>th</sup>. Quarter 2023

- Roadway restoration on Jerome Avenue from E. 233<sup>rd</sup>. Street to Bainbridge Avenue

### Community Impacts

During construction hours, you can expect the following:

- Increased levels of dust, noise and heavy equipment.
- Vehicular travel lane closures will be required, as well as detours. Warning signs will be posted in advance.
- Parking and driveway/loading dock restrictions, signs will be posted within the affected areas.
- Emergency vehicle access and pedestrian access to sidewalk and buildings will be maintained at all times.

### Special Needs

Individuals with special needs who may be uniquely impacted by this construction project should contact the project's Community Construction Liaison, as soon as possible, to make her aware of their situation. DDC will work with you to attempt to minimize the inconvenience as much as possible.

### Water Service Interruptions

During the course of the project, there will be service interruptions. To allow water replacement, the existing water service must be shut off by closing the valves at either end of the section. Advance notice will be given for all planned interruptions. Water service will be restored at the end of the day.

### Trash Collection

Proper trash collection can be a challenge on a project as large as this but if everyone is considerate it can be managed with a modicum of disruption. Please pack your trash properly to avoid easy breakage and/or spill over. Put it in the designated areas as close to collection time as

possible. If you use a private carter, ensure your trash collection occurs in a timely fashion. If you aren't sure where to bring your trash, please call the CCL.

### "No Parking" and Traffic Restrictions

To perform certain work operations and allow construction work to proceed, parking and traffic restrictions are necessary for this project. Advance notification will be given regarding these restrictions, "No Parking" signs will be posted and distributed in advance by the contractor in the affected area. Please follow all signage when posted in order to avoid relocation of your vehicle, otherwise please follow any NYCDOT rules and regulations, to avoid possible towing.
