In 2007 the Nassar family established Tent of Nations on their farm. It is an educational and ecological farm located southwest of Bethlehem in Palestine. Its mission is to build bridges between people and between people and the land. Through creative resistance, organic farming, and educational programs, they seek to transform despair into hope and promote understanding, respect, and sustainability.

The Nassar family has been in the Israeli military and Supreme courts seeking to re-register their land as is required by Israeli law since Daoud Nassar has been sharing the story of his family, and their decision to remain on their land since 2007 in the US and parts of Europe. He writes recently of the current challenges:

"The reality at the Tent of Nations is changing rapidly. The [settler] outpost next to the farm continues to expand. Every day, heavy machinery works directly beside our fence. New facts are being created, and the pressure on the land and on our presence grows. The new land law they are attempting to implement threatens to make life even more difficult for many people and may displace families from the land that has sustained them for generations."
