Mt. Washington Presbyterian Church is sponsoring a book study on theologian and educator Phuc Luu's book Jesus of the East: Reclaiming the Gospel for the Wounded, a deeply moving biblical commentary that seeks to reclaim the biblical Jesus as the Incarnation who gives Himself as a healer, a binder up of the wounds of those who are sinned against. He draws on the concepts of the Korean Han, a community wounded, and minjung theology, the people's theology. His refreshing look at the ministry of Jesus, less about redeeming the sinner and more about the sinned against, gives voice to those on the margins of society.
