We have a few different ways your child can participate in this event.

- We will have an older elementary student reading from the children's book *Manager*. While the student is reading, your children will get to act out different animals that are talked about in the book. We want all children, infants- fifth grade, to participate in this portion of the evening. Once we know how many kids have signed up, we will assign different animals to different children. As a parent, you will be responsible for figuring out a costume for your child. Don't overthink it. - Once we have acted out the book, we will have the opportunity for our kids to stay on stage and be a part of the following three songs we will be singing. This will probably be more appropriate for children three and older. Once you have registered your children, we will send a video link with the songs and motions we will be singing so that you can practice at home.
