


### Messy Spirituality: God's Annoying Love for Imperfect People



Rick received a bachelor's degree from FSU in 1967 with a major in religion and a Master of Divinity degree from Duke University in 1970.



Several people have called the church office to say that they are not receiving the group emails we send out (weekly ENews, Shepherd's Love ...)

There could be a few reasons why this is happening. Sometimes if emails are sent out in a batch, the receiving computer reads it as spam and does not put it in your inbox. Another reason being that if you have not opened the last few copies of what was sent, the computer thinks that this is junk and you do not want it, so it is put in the junk folder.

Open your email and go to the junk folder, which is in the list with Drafts, Sent, Deleted list. Do not open the email. Right click on the email. A list will come up; click on **Junk**. Another list will come up and you need to click **Not Junk**. A box will appear that says "Always trust email from ..... " and there should be a checkmark in the small box. Then click **OK**. That should solve the problem. There have been no changes made to the mailing list or the software we use.
