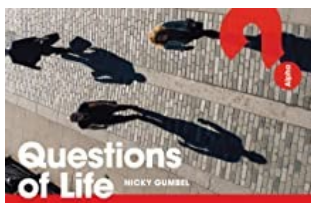
Enough: Discovering Joy Through Simplicity and Generosity

BLUE CHRISTMAS SERVICE

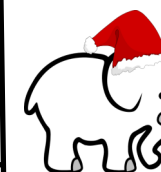
