Naples, Fla. —The Florida Department of Health in Collier County (DOH-Collier), will provide COVID-19 walk-up testing for Immokalee residents on Tuesday and Thursday evenings at Fellowship Church.

This is in addition to daily symptomatic testing and ongoing Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday walk-up testing clinics. Testing availability in Immokalee is as follows:

Testing at DOH-Collier Immokalee site: 419 North First Street, Immokalee, FL 34142.

- Daily, Monday-Friday – 8:00am-5:00pm
Symptomatic testing. Please call the DOH-Collier screening line at (239) 252-6220 ahead of time.
- Monday, Wednesday, Friday – 9:00am-5:00pm
- Sunday – 12:00pm-6:00pm
No referral is needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to provide their name, contact phone number, and address.

Testing at Fellowship Church: 1411 Lake Trafford Road, Immokalee, FL 34142.

- Tuesday, Thursday – 3:00pm-7:00pm
No referral is needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to provide their name, contact phone number, and address.
