Arkansas Hog Inventory Down 1 Percent

Arkansas inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2018, totaled 130,000 head, down 1 percent from December 1, 2017. Breeding hog inventory, at 46,000 head, down 4 percent from the previous year, and market hog inventory, at 84,000 head, down 1 percent from the previous year. For the December 2017 – November 2018 period, the pig crop totaled 1.08 million head, was down 5 percent from the same time period the previous year. Sows farrowing during the period totaled 102,000 head, down 7 percent from the previous year. The average number of pigs saved per litter for December 2017 – November 2018 was 10.60 head, up 2 percent from last year.
