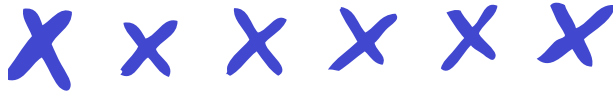

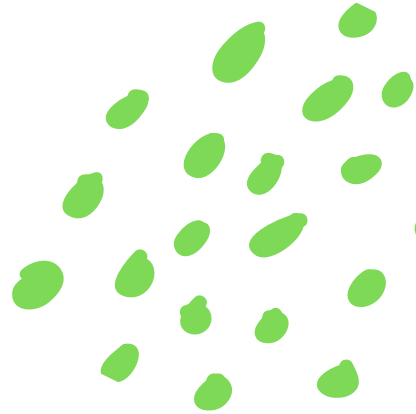
Hello!
