Speech and Language Screenings will be provided at our school on the following dates:

February 25th and 26th

What is a speech and language screening?

- Completed at the child's school during the school day. Parent does not need to be present.
- Screening runs approximately 15 minutes; speech therapist will call parent to follow-up with results of screening once screening is complete
- No formal testing completed; screening protocols may be used depending upon concerns, but no standard scores comparing your child to same-age peers will be obtained. Screening determines whether formal testing is needed.
- Speech therapist informally obtains child's articulation, language and social skills through conversation or play-based activities.
- No formal written report; results are reported to parents verbally following the screening.
