



Homeroom Parent Duties:

This year will look different than previous years until some of our restrictions are lifted. Many of our events will have to be postponed or even cancelled due to the guidelines both here and in other public places. Initially, you may not have very much to do, but we are hoping by the Spring semester (or sooner?) to be able to ease back into some of our normal events.

The duties of a Homeroom Parent are relatively easy. The school provides all the food, paper goods, etc, etc for each event, so the main thing to do is to help distribute those items to the classroom and help in the classroom. *You do not have to be the one that is there all the time, though.* We use Sign-Up Genius for our parents to sign up to volunteer. If you monitor the Sign-Up Genius for classroom events, just make sure your classroom is covered. If no one is volunteering, use the email list of the parents in your classroom, which will be provided to you from the school, and you can send out a friendly reminder that your class needs help.

Sometimes the teacher will ask the Homeroom Parent to complete a project or something similar, but we have staff support here as well, so that usually doesn't happen very often.

The only other thing is that sometimes, *and this is optional*, the HR Parent will organize a classroom gift for the teacher/assistant at Christmas and/or the end of school. Then they would be responsible to collect the monies and purchase the item - unless someone else in the classroom says they'd like to do it.
