## ANCO Travel Awards

Applications for ANCO's Travel Awards to Fellows and Young Clinicians to support attendance at the ASCO Annual Meeting, ASH Annual Meeting, or other national oncology meeting in 2022 are now being accepted.

## **Applicant Requirements**

- 1. Applicant must be an ANCO member in good standing at the time of application submission and during the time of the Travel Award.
- 2. Applicant must be a) in an ACGME-approved training program in northern California in a specialty that will provide care exclusively or predominantly to cancer patients, OR b) practicing in a community oncology practice that provides care exclusively or predominantly to cancer patients AND have been in private practice for five or fewer years.

## **Submission Requirements**

- 1. A current CV.
- 2. A letter of recommendation confirming trainee status in good standing from the Fellowship Program Director OR from a senior partner at the applicant's private oncology practice.
- 3. A one-page personal statement reflecting on each of the following:
- a. Personal/professional goals in attending the ASCO Annual Meeting, ASH Annual Meeting, or other national oncology meeting.
- b. Specific description of the subject matter the applicant is most interested in learning about at the ASCO Annual Meeting, ASH Annual Meeting, or other national oncology meeting.
- c. Impact ANCO has had on the Applicant's training or career development.
- d. If a Fellow, the likelihood of practicing in northern California upon completion of training. Submissions should be sent to <u>director@anco.org</u>.

## **Selection Process**

- a. Application deadline is March 31.
- b. Applications will be reviewed and Awards granted by an ANCO Awards Committee.
- c. Awardees will be informed no later than April 30.
