



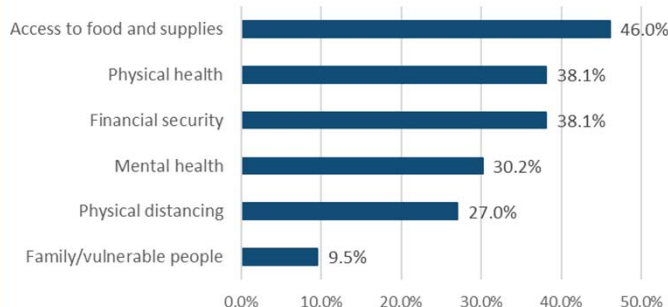

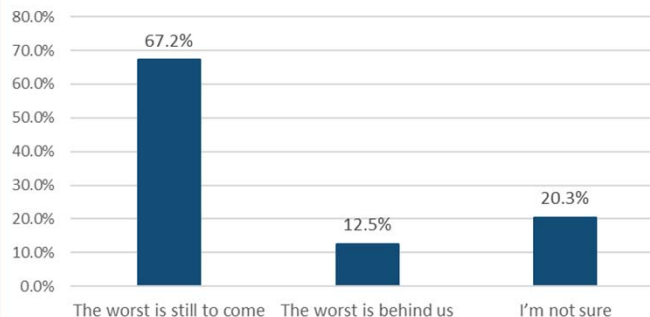
64 Indigenous respondents from across Saskatchewan responded to an online survey between April 7-13, 2020

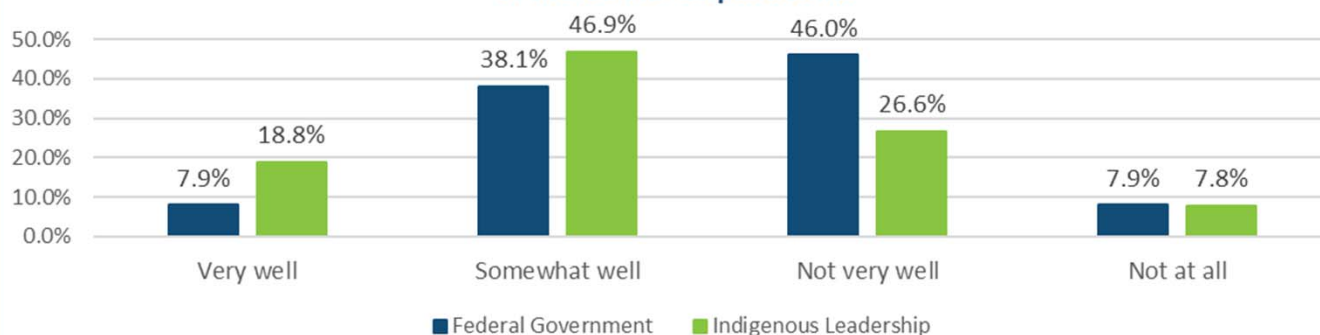
As an Indigenous person, what is most important to you during the COVID-19 pandemic?



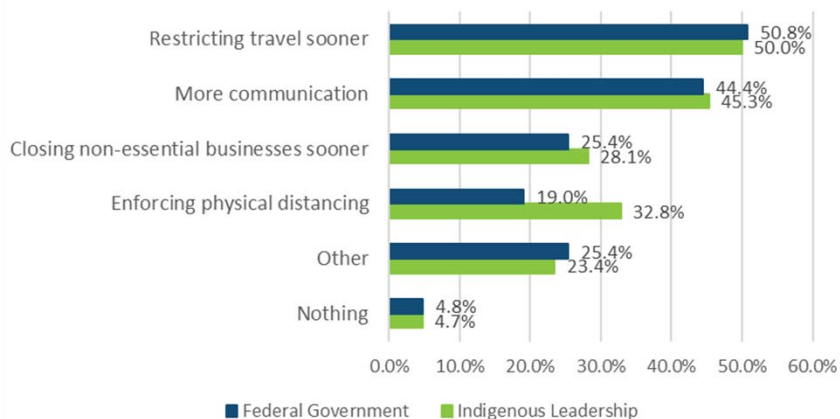
Which of the following best describes your view about the COVID-19 pandemic?
