1. EMPLOYER ELIGIBILITY

An employer is eligible if

they are registered in Canada and can provide a Business / Charitable Registration Number or CRA Organization Number ;	<input type="checkbox"/>
they have the financial capacity to pay the student's salary throughout the placement;	<input type="checkbox"/>
they have or will obtain comprehensive liability insurance prior to the start of the placement;	<input type="checkbox"/>
they provide a safe workplace in Canada;	<input type="checkbox"/>
they are not replacing a displaced worker ; and	<input type="checkbox"/>

2. WIL PLACEMENT ELIGIBILITY

A position is eligible if

the job description is provided for a full-time / part-time position;	<input type="checkbox"/>
the student is hired as an employee , not a contractor / independent contractor;	<input type="checkbox"/>
the position has not started (position can only start after the application has been created);	<input type="checkbox"/>
the position is within the digital economy	<input type="checkbox"/>
the position is Net New : Net new is determined by subtracting the number of students hired in the previous fiscal year from the number of students the company is planning on hiring in the current fiscal year, including those already hired. For example, if the company hired 3 students in the previous fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) then the company must plan to hire 4 students in this fiscal year to qualify for one subsidy.	<input type="checkbox"/>

3. STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

A student is eligible if...

proof of full-time or part-time enrollment at a publicly funded Canadian Publicly Post-Secondary Educational Institution is provided for the placement period Note: A non-coop, work experience outside of the academic courses is also eligible, please email us if you have questions;	<input type="checkbox"/>
proof of Canadian Citizenship/ Permanent Residency/ Refugee Status is provided; and	<input type="checkbox"/>
the student is legally entitled to work in Canada & in applicable province.	<input type="checkbox"/>
