Chakung Jigmed Wangdrak Rinpoche is a fourth-generation descendant of the 19th century master Dudjom Lingpa. Khenchen Jigme Phuntsok Rinpoche and Dakini Kunzang Wangmo requested he teach and preserve the Dudjom lineage. Rinpoche was born in Golok, Tibet and was recognized at 15 as the reincarnation of Rigzin Longsel Nyingpo. He was educated at Larung Gar Monastery, and received pith instructions and wangs from Khenchen Jigme Phuntsok Rinpoche. In Tibet, he published many writings of Dudjom Lingpa, and in 2014, Rinpoche founded The Abhaya Fellowship, a center dedicated to maintaining the Dudjom Tersar lineage. In 2016, Rinpoche opened his East Bay Dharma center, Longsal Ling.
