Here are some online behavior expectations all students must follow.

- If you are not online by 8:15 you will be marked late.
- In order for you to be considered present for the day, we must see your face on camera all day.
- Everyone's microphone should be muted unless you are called on to speak.
- All work must be completed and turned in when it is requested. If work is not turned in by the deadline, you will be given a failing grade accordingly.
- You cannot turn off your camera during the day, and you cannot get up and disappear while classes are occurring.
- Chat bars should only be used if the teacher asks you to use it for class related discussions.
- Your behavior online should mirror your behavior as if you were sitting in the classroom.
