

Easter Break and COVID

What you should do!

If you are traveling to: New York, Pennsylvania, Connecticut, or Delaware you are NOT required to quarantine. If you are passing through an impacted state and stay for less than 24 hours you DO NOT have to quarantine upon return to NJ.

If you are visiting any other state and/or country: your child must quarantine before returning to school. The quarantine guidelines (as of 3/12/21) are as follows:

- Prior to travel, it is recommended that your child gets a viral (not antibody) test 1-3 days before the trip.
- Test 3-5 days after return to New Jersey
- If your child tests negative for COVID-19 AND is asymptomatic the length of the quarantine is 7 days from the date you return to New Jersey.
- If your child does NOT test and is asymptomatic the length of the quarantine is 10 days.
- Quarantine guidelines for travel apply to individuals who have been fully vaccinated.
