RECA Claim Form for Uranium Workers

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The applications for Radiation Exposure Compensation Act claims forms for uranium workers (including miners, millers, and transporters), downwinders, onsite participants, and Manhattan Project waste victims are now available at Justice.gov/Civil/RECA.

Claims forms can be mailed in, along with the required documentation, or submitted online through a virtual portal expected to launch in December. All claims must be filed, with the necessary documentation, by December 31, 2027.

Do not pay for filing assistance. The Navajo Nation has *free* resources to assist you in filing your claims. Contact the following offices for assistance in filing your claims.
