Bridge Back to Life Center Inc. and the Long Island Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence, are proud to announce our third full-day symposium aimed at building community and addressing some of the needs of our military and veteran communities on Long Island. The symposium will be held on Dec 16th, on the campus of Hofstra University.

Our Symposium Planning Committee is comprised of a cross-section of private, not-for-profit, and governmental stakeholders who work and advocate within the military/veteran space on Long Island. The input from this group of both Veterans and civilians has insured that the content and focus of this symposium will be in tune with our military/veteran communities and offer workshops and speakers who are content experts with real-world experience.

Another unique aspect of the Community Strong 2016 Symposium will be a focus on hearing from veterans and military family members- in their own words, regarding their personal experiences from their service eras, including historical and social implications. Our Morning Plenary is a panel discussion titled ***America's Greatest Generations***, and our Afternoon Plenary is a live presentation of ***Comedy Assault*** by Project9line, as well as featured speakers discussing some cutting edge approaches to treatment and recovery. These Plenaries will be interactive.

Last year we had over 220 attendees, with over half being veterans and military family members. We are expecting over 300 attendees this year, representing a cross-section of active duty service members, National Guard and Reservists and Veterans across generations of service. We will also cater to military families, community supporters, service providers, students, and other local advocates from the community.
