Upon completion, eligible students will be given a voucher and have the opportunity to sit for the Certified Associate in Healthcare Information and Management Systems, (CAHIMS), examination, a nationally recognized credential, at no charge.**

In 2016, Suffolk County Community College's Office for Continuing Education received funding from the U.S. Department of Labor to provide qualified workers in the Health IT field. Online Health IT training is now available at no tuition cost if you are eligible.**
