



## Free Motivational Interviewing Training Opportunity for SCC Partner Organizations

### Register for Training on Motivational Interviewing

The Suffolk Care Collaborative (SCC) invites you to participate in a one-day training session on Motivational Interviewing (MI), an engagement technique that can be used by health care and social service professionals to support patients and clients in self-management and assist with health and social needs. The training is sponsored by the Greater New York Hospital Association (GNYHA), and is funded by the New York State Department of Health's (DOH) Health Workforce Retraining Initiative (HWRI).

### About Motivational Interviewing

MI is a collaborative, patient-centered technique to elicit and strengthen motivation for change. MI can be used a mechanism to help individuals identify priorities and engage in treatment and self-management activities. MI techniques provide a framework to guide discussions with patients and clients, and prompt patients to participate in decisions that affect their health.

### Training Details

SCC will host two in-person trainings on the *Spirit of Motivational Interviewing*. The training will include lecture/didactics and interactive learning activities. The session will be facilitated by Bryan Kutner, a member of the Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers. Participants will receive a Certificate of Training from the SCC. Each session can accommodate a maximum of 25 people, so register early!

### Who Should Attend the Training

The training is open to a wide range of health and social service professionals, including, but not limited to, community health workers, community navigators, health coaches, care transitions staff, nurses, social workers, care coordinators and care and case managers. Staff from hospitals, community-based practices, independent physician offices, community-based organizations, social services or other SCC partners may attend. Please note that the DOH HRWI program does not fund trainings for physicians.
