

Children's Access to Primary Care

Measure Type: HEDIS (claims) / Age Cohorts: (12 months – 24 months), (25 months – 6 years), (7 -11 years), (12 -19 years)



Measure Definition

Percentage of children who had a visit with a primary care provider during the measurement year.

Documentation Required

Ambulatory or preventive/wellness care visit **with PCP (excludes specialist visits)**

Primary Care Practitioner (PCP): A Physician or nonphysician (e.g., NP, PA) who offers primary care medical services.
Primary Care Providers include: Family Practice, Internal Medicine, OB/GYN and Pediatrics

Role of Care Management

- Patient/Family reminder calls
- Verification of last visit with patient
- Identify & Address barriers to adherence

Role of PCP Practice

- Outreach to patient & schedule visit
