The cost of the pilgrimage is **\$220**, per person, plus hotel. This will include:

- **Tickets to the Legacy Museum (Sunday afternoon) and the National Memorial for Peace and Justice (Monday).**
- **Loge seating at the Equal Justice Initiative's 30th Anniversary Celebration with Grammy-Award winning artists and, of course, Bryan Stevenson at the Montgomery Performing Arts Center.**

A non-refundable deposit of \$118 is required to reserve your place. A block of rooms has been reserved for St. Paul's at the Embassy Suites Hotel in downtown Montgomery, please contact the hotel directly to reserve your room. The room rate is \$160 for singles and doubles, \$172 for triples/quads, tax included. Full breakfast included daily Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.
