### Main Event Options

There are four different disciplines of target shooting, including

- Sporting Clays
- 5-Stand
- Skeet
- Trap

### Clubhouse Use

- Gathering
- Registration
- Raffles
- Meals

## Golf with a gun

### Sporting Clays "18-hole Golf course."

This event is suitable for parties of 20 or more

Teams go from station to station, shooting pairs of clay targets, with changing target presentation at each station.

### 5-Stand "Mini Golf Course."

This event is suitable for parties of 15 or less

This event takes place on one field, with eight different target presentations, and can be shot from 5 different stands.

### Trap "Driving Range"

This event is used for Warm-ups, Fundraising games, or small events

Targets are thrown at a 45-degree angle, outgoing away from shooters.  
Targets shot as singles from 5 different positions.

### Skeet "Chipping Range"

This event is for minimal events with parties of less than ten guests

Targets are thrown from high and low houses in a crossing pattern.  
Targets shot from 8 different positions around the field.

## **Warm Up**

Not everyone arrives at the same time; we open a Trap field for your shooters to practice. That will allow your guests to familiarize themselves with the guns they might not have shot in a while.

## **Other Items Available for Purchase from Powder Creek**

- 12- or 20-Gauge shells \$12.00 per box (25 shells in a box)
- Eye Protection: \$8.00 per pair
- Ear Plugs: \$.50 per pair
- Golf Carts for sporting clays

## **Facility Before/ After Hours Fee**

A fee will be added to your invoice to hold your event outside business hours.

## **Items NOT included but recommended to bring**

- Water, Snacks, Food, Other Beverages
- Alcoholic Beverages are allowed- but ONLY after shooting is completed
- Catered Meals

## Sporting Clays Head Count / Station Count / Course Closure Policy

Blue Course: 12 Stations (Standard Difficulty)

White Course: 6 Stations (Instructional Difficulty)

Red Course: 12 Stations (Advanced Difficulty)

- Powder Creek recommends 5-person squads

If shooting 50 Sporting Clays per person, your event will be limited to the 12-station Blue Course

- If you are unable to fill at least half of the Blue Course, the Blue Course will not be shut down for your event
  - i.e. 6 of 12 stations filled, 5 person squads, 30+ shooters are needed to shut down the Blue Course
- All organized Corporate Sporting Events will shoot the Blue Course in some capacity
  - Blue Course Only
  - Blue Course plus some White Stations
  - Blue Course plus the whole White Course
  - Blue Course plus the whole White Station plus some Red Stations
- If you are shooting 100 Sporting Clays per person, you will have access to the options listed above: All Blues, All Blues and some Whites, some Reds, etc.
- All Sporting Clays Events of 60 persons or less will be limited to the Blue Course (12 stations, 5 persons per station)

If shooting 100 Sporting Clays per person:

- 60 – 90 persons:
  - Recommend “B-Squads” on the Blue Course or
  - Addition of some or all of the White Stations (12 – 18 stations in total)
    - Recommend 12, 15, or 18 stations
    - Recommend adding B-Squads before adding stations
- 90 – 120 persons:
  - Recommend “B-Squads” on the 18 Station Blue and White Course or
  - Can possibly add two Red Stations for a total of 20 stations
    - Recommend B-Squads before adding stations
- 120+ persons:
  - Recommend Blue Course, White Course, and 7 Red Stations for 25 stations in total
  - Can also create two 12-station courses for 24 stations in total
    - Two 12-station courses will require the event to give away prizes for two different courses and typically adds additional expense to the event in prizes
- 250+ persons:
  - Recommend shutting down the entirety of Sporting Clays
  - Two 15-station courses, prizes needed for each

## **Powder Creek Rules and Regulations**

Your safety is of the utmost importance at Powder Creek. We have adopted the following set of safety rules to keep everyone safe and make your experience the best possible:

**Eye Protection:** Required by everyone on the shooting fields

**Hearing Protection:** Required on all shooting fields

**Loading Gun:** Do not load your gun until it is your turn to shoot

**Pointed Down Range:** Always keep the muzzle of your gun down range

**Action open:** Always carry your gun with action open

**Target Loads Only:** Always use target loads, shot sizes 7 ½, 8, 8 ½, or 9 shot. Larger than 7 ½ is NOT permitted. If you are in question about load, please ask management. Shooting non-permitted ammunition is grounds for removal from the premises.

**Number of Shells:** Never load more shells than needed for that target presentation.

- Trap- 1 Shell
- Trap doubles- never more than 2 shells
- Skeet- never more than 2 shells
- Sporting Clays- Never more than 2 shells
- 5- Stand- never more than 2 shells

## Powder Creek Safety and Conduct Rules

The purpose of these rules is to ensure that all activities are conducted in a safe manner as to protect individuals and the organization, while promoting the shooting sports activities. Our mission is to provide a safe shooting environment, educational experience and enjoyment for our members. Our goal is to protect our shooting heritage and to offer shooting opportunities for our members through education and instruction. (January 1, 2019)

### Safety Rules

1. ALWAYS treat all guns as if they are loaded at all times
2. ALWAYS keep firearms pointed in a safe direction
3. NEVER point a firearm at anyone at any time
4. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use
5. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
6. ALWAYS know your target and what lies beyond it

**Eye and ear Protection:** All persons, including observers, will wear eye and ear protection when inside the fence on trap and skeet fields, the 5-stand area, on the sporting clay courses or at the patterning board. Individuals assume all responsibility for any injury that occurs by not wearing eye and ear protections and agree to hold Powder Creek harmless.

**Loading the shotgun:** Do not load the firearm until it is your turn to shoot. You must be on a designated shooting station for trap and skeet or in the designated stands for 5-stand and sporting clays.

**Action open:** Always carry your shotgun with the action open until you are in a designated shooting position or stand and ready to shoot.

**Number of shells in the gun:** Never load more shells than allowed as listed below. Loading more than allowed ammunition is grounds for removal from premises.

- **Trap:** 1 shell at a time
- **Skeet:** Never more than 2 shells
- **5-Stand:** Never more than 2 shells
- **Sporting Clays:** Never more than 2 shells

**Target Loads only:** Only LEAD shot is approved. Ammunition larger than 12 gauge consisting of 2 3/4" in length and 1 1/8 ounces of shot is **NOT** allowed. Only shot size of 7 1/2 - 9 are allowed. Shooting non-permitted ammunition is grounds for removal from premises. If you are in question about your ammunition meeting this requirement, please ask management to confirm.
