

5-Stand League Rules

5-Stand League will be held once a year in the Summer, typically alongside Trap League. Each season will run for eight weeks, each separated into four 2-Week sessions, and will consist of teams of two shooters. Teams can come out at any time during operational hours within each 2-Week session.

Times and Remote Rental: 5-Stand League does NOT have a set schedule and it is up to each team to find time within each 2-Week session to shoot for score. Teams will need to retrieve the 5-Stand League Remote(s) from the clubhouse, not the standard 5-Stand remote(s). If the 5-Stand is in use by another team, one team mate will still need to drop off their Driver's License and phone number to the Clubhouse as a way to "wait in line", and inform the other team using the 5-Stand that they will need to hand them the remote and retrieve their ID from the Clubhouse, informing the front desk staff of who currently has the remote(s). If the 5-Stand is in use by a non-league participant, they will need to bring back the regular 5-Stand remote(s) while the Team uses the 5-Stand League Remote(s) when it is their turn.

Payments of League Fees: The registration fee is due by the first day of 5-Stand League. Individuals who do not pay the registration fees will not be able to shoot until they have paid. If a shooter has not paid their registration fee by the end of the Session 2, the end of the fourth week which is the middle of the season, it is up to the Team Captain to pay the registration fee for that shooter. Should the fee remain unpaid, the team forfeits their spot and cannot participate in 5-Stand League further.

Costs: Each Shooter will have to pay a \$30 registration fee at the beginning of 5-Stand League. This will cover the expenses of Payouts at the end of the season. All Shooters will pay the member price of \$34 per 4 rounds of 5-Stand. You must also purchase a 5-Stand Count Down Card to hold your rounds if you or your team doesn't already have one, which costs \$5.00 for members.

Team Captain: Each team will assign a Team Captain as well as a team name. The Team Captain will be responsible for checking and signing the scorecard directly after shooting. By turning in the scorecard, the Team Captain agrees that the scores are correct and understands that **all scores are final**. The Team Captain is also responsible for providing the names and contact information for anyone on the team who wishes to receive notifications from Powder Creek. The Team Captains of Lewis Class winning teams are responsible for contacting Powder Creek to receive their awards. Team Captains are responsible for notifying team members of 5-Stand closures due to weather, Corp. Events or any other reasons.

Target & Menu Setting: Both 5-Stands will be set up for each 2-Week session on the Sunday prior, and will remain that way until the end of that 2-Week session. **Once the Blue and Red 5-Stand targets and menus are set and posted, you may NOT practice shooting the targets and menus before recording them for score. Your first attempt at shooting the targets and menus must be for official score. This follows official NSCA Rules and Practices.** Practice is allowed after the team shoots and documents their score, and they must be held accountable for their hits and misses. Powder Creek will not provide pullers for 5-Stand league and will trust our participants to be truthful with their scores.

Scoring Discrepancies: These must be addressed immediately. Team Captains must inform the Lady of The Leagues if there is an error with the scores and either a solution or compromise must

be made. Team Captains should be sure to review the scorecard and totals before turning them in. Scores may be updated if there are additional errors found upon the final audit of the scorecard by management.

Make-ups/Pre-shoots: 5-Stand League does not permit Make-Ups or Pre-Shoots, as the targets are set for the 2-Week session only, and will not be duplicated for missed time. If a team fails to shoot within the 2-Week session, they will receive a ZERO, and the scores will not be averaged out at the end of the season.

Substitute Shooter: Substitute shooters are NOT allowed for 5-Stand League.

Weather Policy: Powder Creek does allow shooting in the rain. However, if lightning is present within a ten (10) mile radius of the Shooting Park, all individuals will be asked to vacate the shooting fields. If the weather calls for rain or thunderstorms, please be sure to call or check our website for closures.

Payouts: At the end of 5-Stand League, teams will be ranked from first to last place based on team scores. Winnings will be based on a Lewis Class payout system. Each Class will be awarded the same amount of money. The number of teams participating in 5-Stand League will determine how many Lewis Classes there will be.

Payouts within each Class will be: 1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 30%.

Safety: Your safety is important at Powder Creek. We have adopted the following rules to keep everyone safe and make your experience the best possible:

- Eye Protection: Required by everyone on the shooting field.
- Hearing Protection: Required on all shooting fields.
- Loading Gun: Do not load your gun until it is your turn to shoot. Only one shell allowed in the gun at a time.
- Pointed Down Range: Always keep the muzzle of your gun downrange.
- Action Open: Always carry your gun with the action open.

Target Loads Only: Always use target loads, shot sizes 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2, or 9 shot, LEAD shot only. Shot size Larger than 7 1/2 is not permitted. If you are in question about load, please ask management. Shooting non permitted ammunition is grounds for removal from the premises.

Conduct: Shooters are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanship-like manner. Any conduct such as physical abuse, verbal abuse, or threats of any type directed to shoot personnel, other competitors, or any other persons, whether on or off the shooting line, may result in being asked to leave the property.
