

### Additions to street resurfacing for 2017

In 2019 the City of Sheboygan and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation will be reconstructing North Avenue from North 15<sup>th</sup> Street to Calumet Drive. This joint project will cost an estimated \$3.9 million dollars. The project will consist of new concrete pavement, sidewalks, new street lighting, additional landscaping, improved railroad crossing and traffic signals at the intersection of North Avenue and North 15<sup>th</sup> Street.

Because this section of North Avenue is not being reconstructed until 2019, the City of Sheboygan Department of Public Works (DPW) will be constructing some temporary repairs on North Avenue. In June of 2017, the DPW crews will use the City's asphalt paving machine to place asphalt 1-1/2 inches to 2 inches thick on the westbound driving lane of North Avenue. This temporary asphalt mat will provide a durable driving surface until this section of North Avenue is reconstructed in 2019. The eastbound driving lane of this same section of North Avenue will have the same asphalt treatment applied but not until late July. Underground utility work needs to be done this summer in the eastbound driving lane before this temporary asphalt can be applied.

Tentatively scheduled for reconstruction in 2022 is S. Business Drive from Union Avenue to Washington Avenue. This project will consist of new concrete pavement, sidewalk, new street lighting and additional landscaping. In June of 2017, the DPW crews will use the City's asphalt paving machine to place asphalt 1-1/2 inches to 2 inches thick on the northbound and southbound driving lanes of this section of S. Business Drive. This temporary asphalt mat will provide a durable driving surface until this section of S. Business Drive is reconstructed in 2022.
