

Attention! Are you interested in running for a City of Sheboygan Alderperson office?

The office of City of Sheboygan Alderperson will be open in all Districts in the City during the Spring 2018 Election. Candidates may begin circulation of their nomination papers on or after December 1, 2017. The deadline to file candidacy papers with the City Clerk is by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2018. A candidacy informational packet may be obtained from the City Clerk's Office (828 Center Avenue, Suite 100). Please call (920) 459-3361 with any questions.

Nomination papers can be obtained at the City Clerk's Office, for the Office of Alderperson: a minimum of 20 signatures are required and a maximum 40 of signatures may be turned into the City Clerk.

There are 10 Alderperson Districts in the City of Sheboygan

**Alderpersons in Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 will run for a two year term.

**Alderpersons in Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 will run for a one year term.

The position of Sheboygan Alderperson is a part-time position. The residents elected to the position of Alderperson are expected to attend several meetings each month. The City Council meets twice a month, usually the first and third Mondays of each month. Each alderperson will be appointed to at least one Standing Committee, but not more than two Standing Committees. The Standing Committees are scheduled to meet twice a month in the week following Council meetings. All alderpersons are members of the Committee of the Whole which meets at the call of the Chair. The Standing Committee meetings are scheduled on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday at 4:00 p.m. or later in the evening. The annual salary for Sheboygan Alderpersons is \$4,468.
