

WINTER PARKING RULES



The City of Sheboygan instituted winter parking rules in the year 2000. The winter parking rules help the Department of Public Works remove snow from both sides of the street during snow and ice occurrences without calling a snow emergency. The

rules also help the police department identify abandoned vehicles.

Alternate side parking is in effect from December 1 through April 1 between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m.

On odd-numbered days, between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. vehicles shall only be parked on the side of the street having odd-numbered street addresses (east and south sides).

On even-numbered days, between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. vehicles shall only be parked on the side of the street having even-numbered street addresses (north and west sides).

Streets posted with “No Parking” restrictions shall remain in effect; therefore are NOT under alternate side parking rules.

The simple rule to remember is always park for tomorrow.
