The City of Sheboygan has signed a contract with Mike Miller owner of EOS Surf Shop, 510 North 8th Street in Downtown Sheboygan who is taking over management of the Quarry Beach and waterfront this summer, ushering in a new era for the historic Jaycee Park Quarry. Surf shop owner Mike Miller said they will keep what's already working at the beach, such as the inflatable swim area, but also plan to expand offerings at the adventure park. "It's a piece of Sheboygan history. I went there as a kid," Miller said. "I think it has more potential than what is there right now."

"We have been working on cleaning and improving the grounds, adding more water park features and rentals with lessons and group outings. As we have been working on the grounds and facilities, it brought back a lot of memories of my childhood outings at the park in which has inspired more ideas for future expansion and exciting things to offer! We are excited to announce that we are open for the 2017 summer."

The new venture is now called Sheboygan Quarry & Adventure Park. The area has access to a beautiful warm water beach, inflatable aqua park with kayak and stand up paddleboard rentals. The grounds have been cleaned and improved. More water park features and rentals with lessons and group outings have been added.
