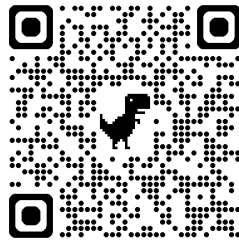

Wi-ACT (Wilton Interfaith Action Committee: "We Act Together for Good!") of which Temple B'nai Chaim is a very active member, packages these meals using bulk ingredients and packaging equipment provided by highly rated nonprofit **RAH** (Rise Against Hunger, Inc.) with **Wi-ACT** paying for the cost of those bulk ingredients and **RAH** transporting them to wherever the need is greatest in the world. These meals are served in school settings where children can be properly nourished.

This annual intergenerational event brings together over 650 Christian, Hindu, Jewish & Muslim volunteers from across our community to package enough meals in one day to feed over 400 otherwise starving children for one whole year as our Wilton faith communities join forces to meet this pressing need. Children as young as 7 can participate if they are accompanied by a parent or guardian who is volunteering. Children 13 years of age or older can sign up on their own.
