



Immunization Requirements for School Attendance in Ohio for Incoming 7th Graders

All students entering 7th grade are required by Ohio School Law to show proof of the following immunizations before starting 7th grade:

- Tdap vaccine to protect against Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis
- Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine to protect against Meningitis

Any student who has not had the Tdap and MCV4 vaccinations prior to entering 7th grade will not be permitted to attend school until proof of these immunizations has been received by the school.

Both required vaccinations can be obtained at any time from now until the first day of 7th grade. We encourage you to contact your physician or the Clermont County General Health District (513) 735-8400 to schedule an appointment.

Please complete and return this form – or an updated Immunization Record from your physician with these vaccination dates – to school prior to the start of 7th grade.
