## PARKING:

The closest visitor parking lot to the location is the **Julesburg or Kiowa Lot** which is marked with a P on the map to the right.

**PAY AT KIOSK:** After hours parking is \$1 and can be purchased at the kiosk located in the Julesburg or Kiowa Lot using the Pay By License Plate method. You will need to **know your license plate number** when you purchase parking. You don't need to display a receipt on your dash.

**The machines do not give change**, so be sure to pay the exact amount or plan to use a Debit/Credit card. There can be long lines at the kiosk to pay, so please plan extra time due to the large attendance we are expecting.

**PAY BY PHONE APP:** You can pay for parking using [www.ParkMobile.com](http://www.ParkMobile.com). You can set up an account online before you come and load the App on your smartphone. When you arrive at the event, you can park and pay for your parking using your phone. You can find the

Parking Zone for the parking lot on green signs in the lot where you park. The Julesburg Lot Parking Zone is **4805** or Kiowa Lot **4806**. You don't need to visit the kiosk or put anything in your windshield, but instead, your license plate is recorded and sent to our parking office to show you have paid for your parking.

Please **do not** park in Children's Hospital Visitor parking because this is not a hospital event.
