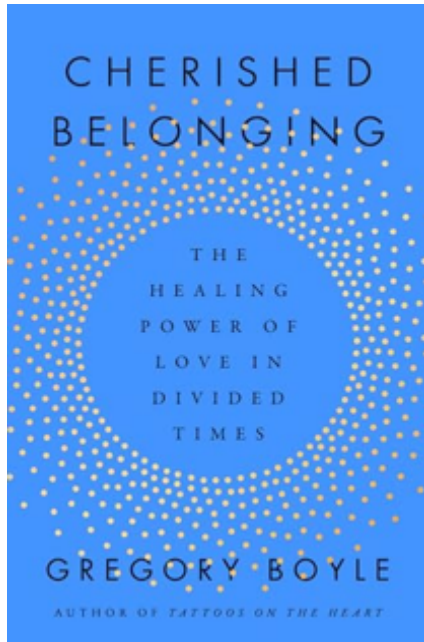

His most recent book describes the belief in compassion, redemption, and healing that infuses the community that Homeboy Industries creates for gang members.
