- May 17: *Learn about Restorative Arlington* with Tracy McLoone

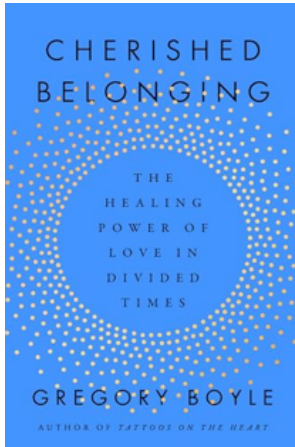

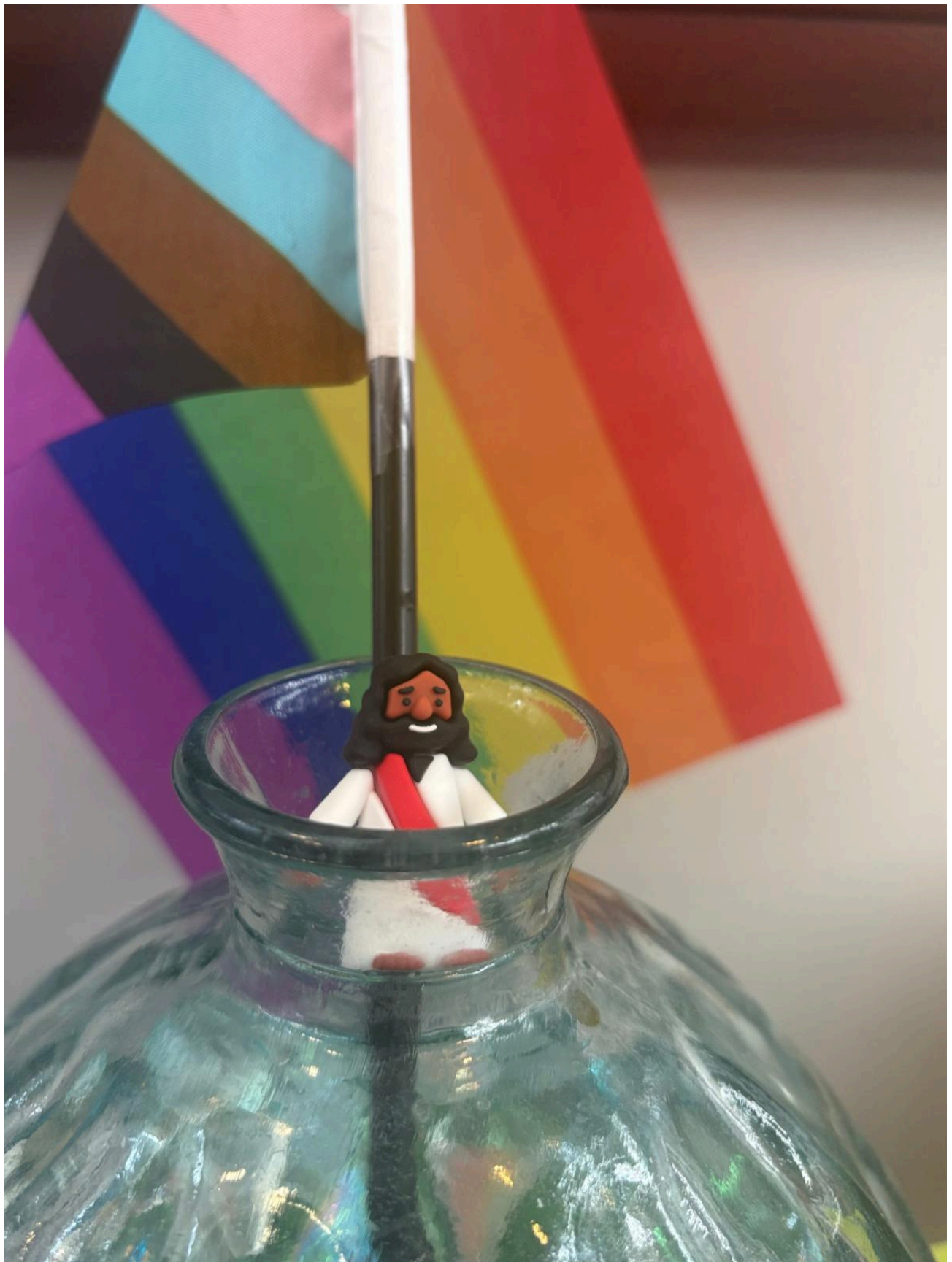
