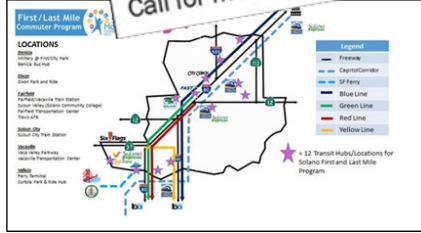

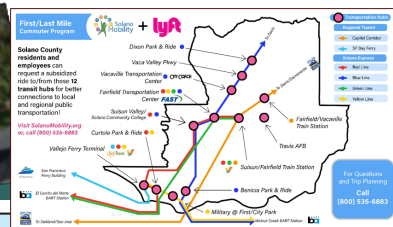

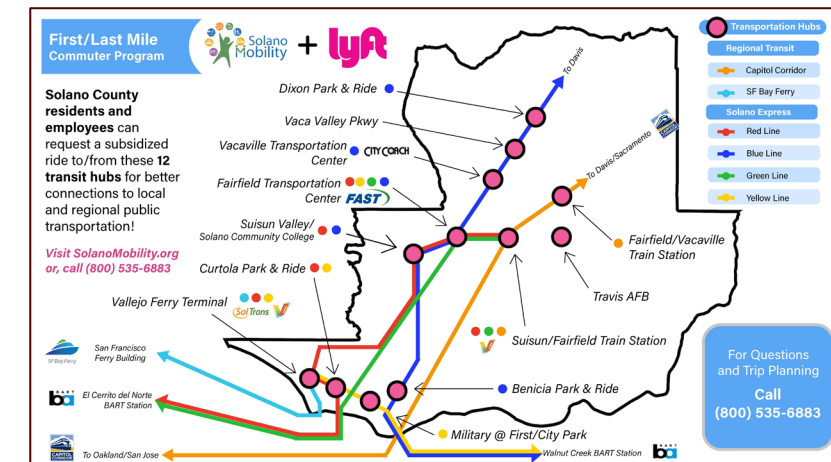
Program Spotlight First/Last Mile

Background

- Pilot connecting Suisun/Fairfield Train Station to Business Park began in 2017

Purpose

- Supports Fixed-Route Transit & Encourages Alternate Transportation Use
- Connect **work commuters** using alternate transportation modes with 12 Solano County Transit Hubs
 - All Solano County Transportation Centers
 - Two Solano County Train Stations
 - All Solano Express Bus Stops





Program Spotlight First/Last Mile

Participation Requirements

- Live or work in Solano County (must commute for work)
- 18+
- Traveling to/from Solano County home/**work**

Participant Benefits

- 60% off Lyft rides up to \$20/80% for low-income qualified
- 45 rides/month
