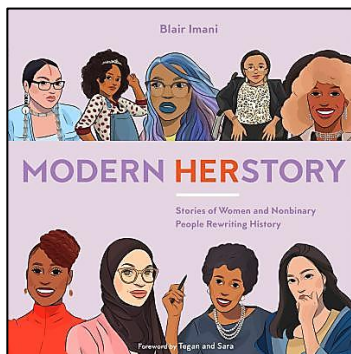
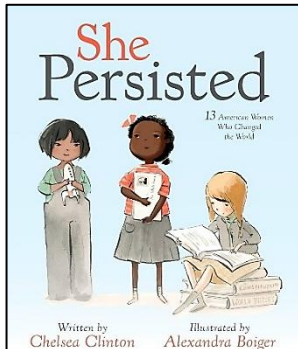

I read for pleasure only. I like most mystery authors and some romance novels.

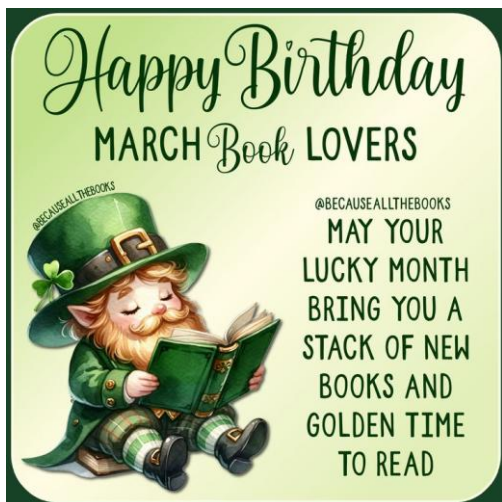
What do you like to do for fun?

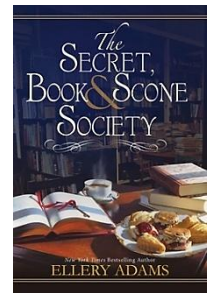
AUTHOR/BOOK REVIEW



I recently discovered a new author that I absolutely love: **Ellery Adams**. Because I'm involved with Lakeside Friends of the Library and its bookstore, her work immediately caught my attention. Many of her series center on bookstores, books, and strong friendships—making them especially appealing. While

Adams's books are classified as mysteries, they offer so much more than that, with rich characters and heartfelt connections that keep readers fully engaged.

My first introduction to her writing was the **Secret, Book & Scone Society** series. Set in the small town of Miracle Springs, North Carolina, the story follows four close friends who are also small business owners. They often gather at Miracle Books for girl time, book club discussions, and—inevitably—conversations about the latest murder that seems to have cropped up. Adams draws readers in with vivid descriptions and well-paced plots that make the setting feel warm, inviting, and intriguingly mysterious.



Another series I'm currently enjoying is her **Book Retreat Mysteries**. This series takes place in rural western Virginia at the beautiful Storyton Hall, a resort designed especially for bibliophiles. Guests come to relax with books, attend literary events, or try to access the resort's legendary secret library—a collection of rare books spanning generations. With dead bodies, secret passages, and plenty of action, this glorious book retreat series keeps you turning pages and wanting more.

Enjoy all the cozy mystery twists found in each of Ellery Adams's books.
