<p>All person in Florida shall continue to limit personal interaction outside of the home and continue to practice all universal precautions recommended by the CDC. Avoid congregating in large groups of more the 50 persons and use caution on nonessential travel (including within US with significant presence of COVID-19).</p>	
<p><i>Senior citizens and individuals with a significant underlying medical condition(s) are strongly encouraged to stay at home and take all measures to limit the risk of exposure to COVID-19.</i></p>	
<p align="center">Commercial restrictions and guidelines</p>	
Restaurants	Dining rooms may open with 50% indoor capacity (excluding employees) and with appropriate social distancing . Outdoor seating is allowable with social distancing. Appropriate social distancing requires maintaining a minimum of 6-ft between parties, only seating parties of 10 or less.
Gyms and Fitness Centers	Gyms and fitness centers will be allowed to fully reopen using adequate social distancing and frequent sanitizing
Bars, Pubs, and Nightclubs	Bars, Pubs and counters may reopen with seated service at 50% occupancy. With appropriate social / physical distancing and universal precautions.
Retail Stores	May reopen with full capacity and continue with guidelines from the CDC and OSHA.
Museums & Libraries	May reopen with 50% capacity . Any interactive functions, exhibits and play areas must remain closed.
Vacation Rentals	Vacation rentals or transient lodging establishments that are rented for less than 30 days may operate under the Collier County safety plan.
Hotels & Lodging	Continue to operate as essential business and follow State of Florida, CDC, and OSHA guidelines.
Medical Procedures	<p>Elective procedures may resume if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities have the ability to convert surgical beds to ICU beds for Covid-19 patients if needed. • The facility has adequate PPE to complete all procedures and respond to Covid-19 treatments, without seeking assistance for PPE • The facility has not sought additional PPE assistance since resuming elective procedures. • The facility has not refused to provide support to and proactively engaged with skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities and other long-term care residential providers.
Essential Businesses	Continue to operate as essential business and follow State of Florida, CDC, and OSHA guidelines.
Non-Essential Businesses (not specified in EO 20-139)	Unless otherwise stated, all other businesses shall remain closed during Phase-2 of reopening. <i>*Businesses with on-site retail sales shall comply with regulations for Retail Sales listed above.</i>
