Do you need a safe place to dispose of your medications?

We accept:
Over-the-Counter Meds
Prescription Patches
Prescription Medications
Pet Medications
Vitamins

We cannot accept:
Business or Client Meds
Needles (Sharps)
Thermometers
Inhalers
Liquids
Lotions
Aerosol Cans

Inhalers and nose sprays can be placed directly in household trash.

Needles, including EpiPens, should be placed in a heavy plastic container with a lid, labeled 'sharps', and placed in household trash.
