



Moraga Library will be closed on Tuesday, November 11 for Veterans Day. We will also be closed on Thursday, November 27 for Thanksgiving Day.








COMMUNITY OFRENDA

LECTURE WITH GERALD HENIG

Triangle, The Fire that Transformed Industrial America Saturday, November 1 | 12:00 PM - 3:00 PM
ON March 25, 1911, a cataclysmic fire swept through the Triangle Shirtwaist Factory. One hundred and forty-six employees perished, most of whom were Jewish and Italian immigrant women and girls. Many of the issues that the Triangle fire raised remain in the forefront today. Professor Gerald Henig will describe the circumstances leading to this horrific tragedy, and explain why it happened, who was responsible, and its consequences.


