### **Assessing for All**

All children can learn effectively and demonstrate being successful in their own individual way. In this training, trainees will understand a variety of formal and informal ways they can assess students in the early childhood setting, which will allow for differentiation and accountability, without any limitations. Assessment is not a definite and it is not just a score. Each child deserves to be assessed based on his or her own true potential through differentiation. When we use a variety of assessments for all students in our care, we are getting results for the abilities they can accomplish at their level, rather than just a final set outcome we want to measure as a whole.
