New Business

• Church Property Vision Update: Team members, Pastors, and Christina shared a brief update from the May 29 Church Property Vision Team meeting. The team reviewed several land use concepts proposed by a potential partner, with particular interest in 55+ senior housing models. The team currently favors selling the land outright, rather than leasing, to simplify responsibilities and support a mission-aligned

development. There is also interest in potential shared space or partnership opportunities. Pastor Dale has followed up with this potential partner for more details ahead of the next team meeting (June 23), where a S.W.O.T. (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats) analysis will be led by team member Wendy Hazard to support continued discernment. There is still no official timeline—this process remains exploratory. It was noted that the potential partner recently became aware their possible involvement was mentioned publicly. Because these conversations are still in early stages and not yet shared within their internal team, they have respectfully requested: That no further public mentions or printed references be made at this time, and that we manage messaging carefully until a more defined proposal is developed. Moving forward, we will refer to them as a potential partner until a pre-development agreement is reached.

- Mission Support Celebration Dinner August 18: The Saint Paul Area Synod invites us to a Mission Support Celebration Dinner on Monday, August 18, from 6–8 p.m. at St. Andrew's, Mahtomedi. As a redevelopment congregation, it is important to be represented. Christina and Andrew Fashner, along with Pastors Carrie and Dale, plan to attend and express thanks.
- New Little Free Library Location & Next Steps: Steve England is building a Little Free Library as a gift
 to the church and community. The newly formed Hospitality Team will maintain it. Pastor Carrie will
 ensure it is registered nationally. A motion to approve the project and its location was made by
 Christina Fashner, seconded by Thomas Stoyke. Motion passed.
